MEMBERSHIP FEES**

As provided by Rule 6 of the Association the Board has determined that the following fees for Membership shall apply:

Life Members

The one-time fee for Life Membership is \$7,300 (previously \$7,000). This includes a \$6,570 (previously \$6,300) tax deductible donation.

Explanatory notes and additional information

1. To qualify for a concession rate the Member must:
be in receipt of a Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs Pension, in which case they will be required to provide the relevant pension number
2. Joint rates may apply where two people live at the same address. To qualify for the concession rate both people must meet at least one of the criteria set out in (a). In both cases, pension numbers or evidence of student status must be provided.
3. Where a Joint Membership Fee has been paid both people will be Members of the Association and so entitled to vote and stand for office. However, only one mailing will be sent to the address.
4. The Corporate Fee applies to bodies corporate. The Member may apply to the Board to have the fee reduced to that applicable to Gold subscribers.
5. The renewal date for annual membership fees is the last day of the month in which the Member joined. Renewal notices will be sent out on a monthly basis. Where a Member does not renew their membership in response to an initial renewal notice, reminder notices will be sent (if necessary) in each of the next two months. If the Membership Fee remains unpaid after that time, the membership will be deemed to have lapsed.
6. The Board established a Student Fee as from 25th January 2017. To qualify for this rate, the member must be in possession of a Student Card from a recognized secondary or tertiary institution.
